

WHAT IS BACKEND DEVELOPER P

- Works behind the scenes of applications and websites.
- Builds the logic that makes apps function correctly.
- Connect the fronend (what the users see) with the server and database.








WHAT IS FRONTEND DEVELOPER ?





• Design and develops buttons, forms and pages

• Focus on the user experience and design

MYROLE

- <u>Coding</u> writing code, databases queries and business logic
- <u>Debugging</u> Investigating and fixing issues in my code
- Teamwork Sharing ideas and problems with my team
- <u>Collaboration</u> Working with frontend, product, QA and Devops teams
- <u>Reviews</u> Participating in code reviews and providing feedback

DIFFERENT COMPANIES

Large companies (Corporates/1000+ employees):

- Very specific role Focus on one service/component
- Work-life balance Flexible
- Strong processes Code reviews, QA, Devops teams

Medium companies (Series B, 50-250 employees):

- Borader scope Developers own several services
- Work-life balance Can vary, sometimes longer hours around deadlines
- Processes Still exists but allow innovation



DIFFERENT COMPANIES

Early- Stage Startups (Pre-seed/ 2-50 employees):

- Role Almost full-stack by default everyone touches everything
- Work-life balance Challenging often intense and demanding
- Processes Doesn't exists focus on delivery

DIFFERENT COMPANIES

Large companies

- Better work-life balance
- Structured role
- Less personal impact

<u>Startups</u>

- Broader scope
- Faster growth
- No work-life balance



REQUIRED SKILLS

TECHNICAL SKILLS

- Programing languages: Java, Python, Node.js....
- <u>Databases</u>: SQL (PostgreSQL,MYSQL) and NoSQL(MongoDB,Redis)
- Cloud Platfroms: AWS, Azure
- Working with IDE's: Intelliji, VS Code
- Version Control: Git&GitHub/GitLab for code managment

REQUIRED SKILLS SOFT SKILLS

- Problem-Solving: Ability to break down complex challenges
- Collaboration: Working with frontend, product and devops teams
- Communication: Explaining technical concepts clearly
- <u>Adaptability</u>: Learning new technologies quickly in a changing environment (Start up)

- Junior backend/full-stack developer
- QA Engineer builds strong debugging and testing skills
- <u>Data Engineer</u> experience with databases
- Technical Support hands on with servers



HOW TO SEARCH FOR A BACKEND DEVELOPER ROLE

- CV Highlight backend skills (databases, cloud, APIs)
- Linkedin Connect with devlopers, recuiters and tech communities
- Prepare Practice coding interview quesions (leetcode)
- Projects Build a strong GitHub with open-source projects.



OTHER HELPFUL ACTIONS

- Networking Attend meetups and hacktons to connect with people
- <u>Referrals</u> Ask collegues, mentors or friends in tech for recommendatios
- <u>Learning</u> Keep improve your skills and share knowledge (Linkedin)
- Consistency Job searching takes time persistence is the key!
